Mayor Gordon called the meeting to order at 5:31 p.m.

Mayor Gordon stated Council is resuming with the original item #1: Work Session on the 2015 Preliminary Budget on Public Works.

WORK SESSION:

2015 Preliminary Budget on Public Works - Ms. Miller

Finance Director Miller reviewed with Council the Public Works Preliminary Budget shells.

Councilmember Morgan entered the meeting at 5:43:58 p.m.

Mayor Gordon announced since Mr. Boettcher is now present, Council would like to move on to item #2: Work Session on the Rock Creek Bridge Project and will return to the 2015 Preliminary Budget.

Rock Creek Bridge Project – Mr. Boettcher

Peter Rimbos, Maple Valley – commented on the Rock Creek Bridge Project and the structural integrity of the bridge. He gave his background credentials regarding engineering and what needs to be done in the studies now so the City is not on the hook. He commented on changes needed in the Scope of Work such as the Assumptions as he believes they could be inadequate.

Public Works Director Boettcher responded to Mr. Rimbos' comments.

Motion passed with all voting in favor (3-1, Morgan).

Finance Director Miller continued to review with Council the Public Works Preliminary Budget shells.

Resolution No. 14-984, authorizing the Mayor to execute the First Addendum Consultant Services Contract with Parametrix for a MDRT Planner

Ms. Martinez reported that the resolution before Council is an amendment to the contract with Parametrix to continue providing a MDRT Planner through 2014. She noted she checked with Ms. Miller and there is money in the budget and that all costs associated with this contract will be reimbursed by the Developer.

A motion was made by Councilmember Edelman and seconded by Councilmember Taylor to adopt Resolution No. 14-984, authorizing the Mayor to execute the First Addendum Consultant Services Contract with Parametrix for a MDRT Planner. Motion passed with all voting in favor (4-0).
