ORDINANCE NO. 18-1114

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2019

WHEREAS, the Preliminary Budget was submitted to the City Council by the Mayor on November 15, 2018, and

WHEREAS, the City Council held Workstudy meetings and public hearings on the Budget on September 27, 2018, October 18, 2018, October 25, 2018 and November 8, 2018 and held Public hearings on November 8, 2018, November 15, 2018 and December 3, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the 2019 Budget must be adopted by 12/31/2018 for the City to have legal authority to pay employees and/or bills beginning January 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the Budget document was on file with the City Clerk for examination by the public during the time it was being considered by the City Council; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The annual budget of the City of Black Diamond for the 2019 calendar year, a reference copy of the document which is on file with the City Clerk and is posted on the city website, is hereby adopted at the fund level as the annual budget for the City of Black Diamond for the calendar year 2019.
- <u>Section 2.</u> The budget and information contained herein remain provisional to the extent they are subject to mandatory bargaining with the City's collectively bargained employees as required by Washington law.
- <u>Section 3</u>. The total estimated revenue from all sources and expenditures by fund as set forth in the 2019 budget document is adopted as follows:
