ORDINANCE NO. 08-868

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, PROHIBITING SOLICITATIONS ON CITY RECOGNIZED HOLIDAYS, AMENDING SECTION 5.12.100 OF THE BLACK DIAMOND MUNICIPAL CODE, AND DECLARING THIS A PUBLIC EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AND THUS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

WHEREAS, the Council finds that it is in the best interests of the City and its citizens to prohibit uninvited door-to-door soliciting during City recognized holidays; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists because the City recognized holiday of Labor Day is approaching; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 5.12.100 of the Black Diamond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.12.100 Time of solicitations.

No solicitations shall be made except between the hours of ten a.m. and seven p.m. No solicitations shall be made on City recognized holidays.

<u>Section 2</u>. Each and every provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable. If any provision of this Ordinance should be deemed to be unconstitutional or otherwise contrary to the law by a Court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections so long as the intent of the Ordinance can be fulfilled without the illegal section.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Ordinance is hereby designated as a Public Emergency Ordinance necessary for the protection of public health, safety, public property or the public peace and shall be effective upon adoption.
