RESOLUTION NO. 13-851

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTY SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the process to develop the 2013 Budget has identified certain program changes; and

WHEREAS, the program commonly known as "Police K-9" has been discontinued; and

WHEREAS, the dog named Sabre, which is the sole dog in the K-9 program, is surplus to the needs of the City of Black Diamond;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The dog, Sabre, as well as accompanying collars, leashes, blankets or other dog-related equipment not displaying city or city police logos or tags is hereby declared to be surplus to the needs of the City of Black Diamond.

<u>Section 2.</u> The dog, Sabre, may be sold to the Police Officer who has been Sabre's working partner and caregiver for a fee of one dollar (\$1.00). Upon payment of the fee, the dog, as well as accompanying equipment as set forth in Section 1 shall become the property of the aforementioned Police Officer.
