RESOLUTION NO. 13-865

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO ACCEPTANCE OF PROPERTY AND MONEY DONATED, DEVISED, OR BEQUETHED TO THE CITY; ESTABLISHING A POLICY FOR BIANNUAL REVIEW AND ACCEPTANCE

WHEREAS, RCW 35.21.100 provides that, the City may accept by ordinance any money or property donated, devised, or bequeathed to it and carry out the terms of the donation, devise, or bequest, if within the powers granted by law, or, if no terms or conditions are attached to the donation, devise, or bequest, the city may expend or use it for any municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish a policy relating to acceptance of donated, devised or bequeathed property or money;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Biannual Acceptance of Donated Money or Property. It is hereby the policy of the City Council to consider acceptance of money or property donated, devised or bequeathed to the City on a bi-annual basis (July and December), and that all such money or property shall be accepted only by Ordinance, and that, such ordinance shall specify the terms and conditions, if any, attached to each donation, devise or bequest. This policy shall not apply to money or property received by grant and shall not preclude consideration of acceptance of donated, devised or bequeathed money or property at other times when the circumstances warrant such consideration.
