Description of proposal: Timber harvest in accordance with RCW 76.09 to harvest mostly mature Western Red Cedar, Douglas-fir and Bigleaf Maple over approximately 20-acres on a 31-acre parcel. Replanting of the trees will be conducted in compliance with the City of Black Diamond Tree Preservation Ordinance.
